7.	Team Tournament Structure:	Pool Play: - 2 Pools (Pool A & Pool B) with 4 teams in each pool to play round-robin against each team in their pool.
		 Playoffs: First place in Pool A will play second place in Pool B. Second place in Pool A will play first place in Pool B. Winners of these two ties will play for first and second place in their division. Losers of these two ties will play for third and fourth place in their division. Third place in Pool A will play fourth place in Pool B. Fourth place in Pool A will play third place in Pool B. Winner of these two ties will play for fifth and sixth place in their division. Losers of these two ties will play for seventh and eighth place in

their division.

8. Divisions

Competitive

- No age restriction.
- Competitive, local A & B players.

Semi-Competitive

- No age restriction.
- Recreational, local C & D players.

Team Regulations & Requirements:

Maximum 1 entry per player. Players may not play for multiple teams or in multiple divisions due to time constraints.

Competitive Division (MAXIMUM 8 TEAMS) - \$600 per Team.

- Minimum 8 players. Additional \$50 per member after 8 members.
- One Team Captain.
- Minimum 2 women.
- At least 2 women must be included in the line-up for each tie.
- Events per tie:
 - Doubles 1
 - Doubles 2
 - Doubles 3
 - Doubles 4
- Line-ups must be ranked from strongest to weakest.
- Players may only play one match per tie.

Semi-Competitive Division (MAXIMUM 8 TEAMS) - \$600 per Team.

- Minimum 8 players. Additional \$50 per member after 8 members.
- One Team Captain.
- Minimum 3 women.
- At least 3 women must be included in the line-up for each tie.
- Events per tie:
 - Doubles 1
 - Doubles 2
 - Doubles 3
 - Doubles 4
- Line-ups must be ranked from strongest to weakest.
- Players may only play one match per tie.

Tie Regulations:

- 4 Matches per tie:
 - Doubles 1
 - Doubles 2
 - Doubles 3
 - Doubles 4
- Each match is best of three games to 21 points.
- Third game starts at 15-15 and plays to 21 points.
- 1 point is awarded for each match won.
- 2 points are awarded for winning the Golden Match.
- Team with the most points after all matches have been played wins the tie.
- Pool Play: Must play all matches.
- Playoffs: Must play all matches unless there is a time constraint determined by the tournament organizers.

11. Golden Match:

After the lineup has been submitted, the Team Captain of each team will flip a coin to determine who will get to choose first to eliminate a match as the Golden Match. The last match remaining after 3 matches have been eliminated will be

the Golden Match worth 2 points to the team that wins.

For example, Team One wins the coin toss. Team One's captain predicts that Team Two's team will win Doubles 1, so Team One's Captain eliminates that match as the Golden Match. Next, Team Two predicts their team playing Doubles 2 will most likely lose, so Team Two's Captain eliminates Doubles 2 as the Golden Match. With two matches left, Team One will decide the final match to eliminate. The match that remains will be the Golden Match and worth 2 points to the team that wins.

12. Order of Play

- The Golden Match shall be played last in each tie.
- The Team Captain who loses the coin toss after submitting the line-up chooses the first match to play and takes turns with the other Team Captain deciding the order of play.

13. Condition of Play:

- Acceptable badminton clothing must be worn by players.
- Players must be prepared to go on court at the start of the tie; there will be a 10-minute default rule in effect. This applies to all remaining matches in a tie as well.

14. Entries & Deadline:

- All entries must be made online at www.PacificCup.net and full payment must be made online through Paypal by July 4, 2025.
- Late entries and other forms of entry WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- Full team roster MUST BE submitted at the time of entry.
- EACH TEAM MUST HAVE A TEAM CAPTAIN.
- Team Captain MUST complete and submit the team form to info@pacificcup.net
- Team form is available to download at www.pacificcup.net.
- IMPORTANT: Do <u>NOT</u> wait until the last minute to sign up as we expect this tournament to be full before the entry deadline.

15. Withdrawals/Cancellations:

On-Time Withdrawals (Withdrawal by entry deadline: July 4, 2025):

- Players who withdraw by the entry deadline, July 4, 2025, will have their entry fee refunded. The following person must be notified of the withdrawal by email:

- Design must have hard edges. No soft edges like blurring or gradients.
- 300 DPI and fit within 10.5" x 10.5".

- 1. Bellevue Badminton Club's regulations are in place during the Pacific Cup.
